**Project Description**

- 1). Briefly describe the project. What will be done, when and where will project activities take place, and who will be the beneficiaries?**

We have identified a group of youths who came together and constructed a makeshift basketball court in Mnarani, Kilifi. Despite the poor state of the court it attracts no less than 20 youths every evening who participate in basketball games.

The Rotary club of Kilifi proposes to construct a standard basketball court for Mnarani community youths based in Kilifi county. The court will be constructed on land that has been allocated to the Mnarani community for sports and recreational activities. It is expected that the beneficiaries of the basketball court will mainly be youths from Kilifi town since there is no other public basketball court in Kilifi.

The Rotary club of Kilifi will also benefit as the project will create visibility for the club since the basketball court shall be branded with rotary logos. More importantly the project will act as platform for the Rotary Club of Kilifi members to interact with Kilifi youths and discuss issues such as drug abuse and sexual health.

The club intends to construct the court as soon as funds are available.

- 2). How many Rotarians are expected to participate in the project?**

All the club members will be engaged at various stages of the project.

- 3). What will they do? Please give at least two examples.**

- The club members will oversee the implementation of the project from procurement to the construction of the basketball court.

- Once completed we intend to sponsor an annual basketball tournament whereby the Rotary club of Kilifi will sponsor the trophies for the winners.
- Through interaction with the youths during tournaments, the club members will conduct a needs assessment to determine various challenges the youths face with the aim of introducing various interventions.

#### **4). How many non-Rotarians are expected to benefit from this project?**

The youths within Kilifi town and more so Mnarani village will be the main beneficiaries of this project. Through basketball tournaments we intend help in identification of talented youths who can play basketball at a national level. The Mnarani community will also benefit from the project since it will be a place where community members can socialize while watching basketball games.

#### **5). What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?**

Mnarani community is one of the communities in Coastal region whose youths are affected by drug abuse and early teenage pregnancies. Since the basketball court was an initiative of the youths from this community, we believe it will be a successful project that will keep them occupied and away from drugs.

During the Rotary sponsored basketball tournaments, it is possible that some of the youths might be identified for their skills and could end up playing for at a national level or even getting scholarships. The project is also expected to bring the community together and as a result create cohesion and good relationship among the community members.

#### **6). Will a cooperating organization be involved, what will be its role?**

We shall work with Tackle Africa an NGO that utilizes football games to deliver HIV and Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights information and services across Africa. We shall consult them on how we can use similar interventions using basketball.
